



Real Ale Tasting Notes

1. **Brew Buddies: Sessions Buddy 3.7%**
Our new session ale brewed with a light malt base and a medium mouth feel, it is hopped liberally with East Kent Goldings, Aurora and Dana for a smooth hoppiness with fruity and floral character.
2. **Brew Buddies: Stout 4.5%**
A smooth dark stout with hints of chocolate. Hopped with Simcoe in both the boil and dry hop to impart a rich and smooth taste.
3. **Cattle Shed Brew Co: Simcoe 4.3%**
A fruity, clean and refreshing single hop session IPA using a Simcoe hop.
4. **Dartford Wobbler Brewery: Dartford Wobbler 4.3%**
A full-bodied russet brown premium bitter with a dark malt profile, fruit notes and a dry finish.
5. **Dartford Wobbler Brewery: Penny Red 4.4%**
A burnished red-coloured beer that has pungent hop notes, a dry finish and a malty base that drinks greater than its strength.
6. **Goody Ales: Good Sheppard 4.5%**
Deep amber ale with a warm vanilla twist on the palate and a soft feel on the tongue; a beer to guide you home.
7. **Goody Ales: Goodness Gracious Me 4.8%**
India Pale Ale. Robust and citrus flavoured IPA evoking the taste of the Raj during this Indian Summer?
8. **Hopdaemon: Green Daemon 5.0%**
A golden "HELLES" beer with luscious tropical fruit aromas and a clean finish.
9. **Hopdaemon: Skrimshander IPA 4.5%**
An aromatic copper-coloured pale ale brewed with the finest malted barley and Kentish hops for a refreshing taste and a fruity finish.
10. **Kent Brewery: Black Gold 4.0%**
Dark and mysterious with the easy-drinking qualities of a golden ale.
11. **Kent Brewery: Cobnut 4.1%**
Generously hopped, dark and nutty, with no nuts involved!
12. **Kent Brewery: Session Pale 3.7%**
A light and hoppy session beer with hints of citrus and elderflower.
13. **Mad Cat Brewery: Platinum Blonde Ale 4.2%**
Made using a single pilsner lager malt and Cascade, Phoenix and First Gold hops. It has the pale straw colour normally associated with lagers but is less carbonated and definitely an ale. Fruity and less bitter than an IPA.
14. **Mad Cat Brewery: Pow Wow 3.6%**
Very pale, light summer session ale that's not light on flavour.
15. **Mad Cat Brewery: Red Ale 3.9%**
This dark red bitter has an excellent balance of flavour. Malty and dark, but not too sweet. Bitter, but not harsh. Hoppy, but not overwhelming. Session strength, ideal for dark ale lovers.
16. **Musket Brewery: Fife and Drum 3.8%**
A golden ale which produces tantalising tastes and aromas of spice, honey, marmalade, floral and the merest hint of wild blackcurrant.
17. **Musket Brewery: Muzzleloader 4.5%**
Our Kentish ale evokes the faint spicy aroma of well-seasoned, smoked cedar logs and orange drifts from this full-bodied bitter.
18. **Nelson: Friggin in the Riggin 4.7%**
A premium bitter that is mild brown in colour and has a smooth malt flavour with a bitter sweet aftertaste.
19. **Nelson: Nelson's Blood 6.0%**
A strong malty ale that has mellow roast tones. Slightly nutty with a warming aftertaste.
20. **Nelson: Powder Monkey 4.4%**
A dark golden ale with a smooth taste and produces a sweetness on the palate.
21. **Northdown Brewery: Merry Margate 3.8%**
A pale, golden ale with a light, hoppy, citrus taste with a hint of passion fruit.
22. **Northdown Brewery: Papworth Victory Best Bitter 4.2%**
A light amber floral, dry but balanced ale brewed with Northdown, Fuggles, Pacific Jade and Rakau hops.
23. **Old Dairy: Blue Top 4.8%**
Blue Top delivers a satisfying bitterness smoothly balanced with caramel flavours from the Crystal and Maris Otter malts, finished with a refreshing hint of citrus from East Kent Golding, Challenger and Fuggle hops.
24. **Old Dairy: Red Top 3.8%**
Brewed with Maris Otter, Crystal, Brown and Chocolate malts. Savour the delicious toffee flavours with a hint of coffee, balanced against the fruitiness from East Kent Golding, English Cascade and Challenger hops.

25. **Ramsgate Brewery: Gadds No. 5 4.4%**
A traditional Kentish Best Bitter. The aroma is toffee malt & fresh green hops, the flavour is malt, hops and red berries with a full body and lingering bitter finish.
26. **Ramsgate Brewery: SheSells SeaShells 4.7%**
A pale ale with a clean, fresh bitterness and a gorgeous, zesty hop flavour.
27. **Rockin Robin: Reliant Robin 3.7%**
A fresh, hoppy session bitter, dry hopped to create floral aromas. Brewers favourite tipple.
28. **Tonbridge Brewery: Coppernob 3.8%**
Fairly dry ale with a light maltiness and medium bitterness. Robust, fruity flavour.
29. **Tonbridge Brewery: Countryman 4.0%**
Tawny, amber best bitter with a light malty taste and a light floral, spice finish.
30. **Wantsum Brewery: Black Pig Porter 4.8%**
Adapted from an imperial Russian porter recipe, this beer is incredibly smooth with burnt chocolate and smoky malt notes mixed with delicate hop bitterness and floral notes.
31. **Wantsum Brewery: Fortitude 4.2%**
This best bitter combines four types of malts to give a depth of body, with English and American hops for a pronounced hop finish. Wantsum's flagship bitter, first brewed in 2009.

32. **Wantsum Brewery: Red Raddle 5.0%**
A five hop, ruby red premium bitter with biscuit and toasted malt base supporting a broad, hoppy smooth finish.
33. **Westerham Brewery: British Bulldog 4.1%**
A rich, full bodied amber ale in the traditional Kent style.
34. **Westerham Brewery: Spirit of Kent 4.0%**
This golden ale is hopped with nine different types of Kent bred hops in a total of nine separate additions. It has a hoppy, lemon, citrus aroma, with a smooth, sweet malty taste.
35. **Whitstable Brewery: Pearl of Kent 4.5%**
A gorgeous, easy drinking golden ale where tropical fruit flavours come to the fore ahead of a subtle yet rewarding bitterness.
36. **Whitstable Brewery: Winkle Picker 4.5%**
A beautifully balanced amber best bitter; winkle pickers maltiness offset by a firm but not overpowering bitterness and a delightful hint of orange delivers everything one could desire from a classic best bitter.
