Real Ale Tasting Notes

1. Bexley Brewery: Bexley's Own 4.2%

Deliciously smooth pale ale. This ale is made with a combination of Crystal malts together with UK and New World hops, giving a floral aroma with a well balanced flavour of gentle bittering and a lingering subtle sweetness.

2. Bexley Brewery: Black Prince Porter 4.6%

Combines brown, chocolate, black and crystal malts to produce a dark rich ale with a roasted, vanilla aroma and a sweet chocolate, coffee flavour

3. Bexley Brewery: Bursted 3.8%

A dark amber biscuity bitter and full of malty flavour, it also makes a great bitter shandy!

4. Brumaison: 1770 4.7%

Award-winning, dark brown porter with reddish hue. Full malt flavour, warm with hints of coffee and chocolate. Light bitterness from Kent Bullion hops and little or no hop aro-

5. Brumaison: Bullion 4.5%

Bullion ale is a refreshing single hop pale ale. A refreshing ale with a delicate zesty, spicy flavour that is not overpowering.

6. Brumaison: Roister 4%

Cask conditioned English pale ale. Perfectly balanced bitterness against the aroma and flavour of the Ernest hop giving hints of sweet spice and peach.

18. Iron Pier: Old Ale 4.3%

25. Mad Cat Brewery: Big Stik! 4.4%

Big Stik! is a delicious pale ale dry-hopped with a massive dose of Rakau - a fantastic variety from New Zealand whose name is a Maori word for a wooden staff. Expect a hop punch with intense aromas of peach, apricot and orchard fruit, as well as a crisp bitter bite. Big Stik! is perfect for all you hop-heads out there

26.. Mad Cat Brewery: Emotional Blackmail 4.5%

Delicious ruby ale, with a touch of peppery rye and background of rich dried fruits.

27.. Mad Cat Brewery: Jet Black Stout 4.5%

All stouts are black, but this is jet black stout! Roasted barley and black malt provide depth of colour and lend a dry bitterness, with hints of coffee and dark chocolate, which is balanced with caramel malts and oats that provide sweetness and body.

28. Mad Cat Brewery: Unsinkable Sam 5.2%

This is no ordinary bitter. Suped-up with extra hops and malty character, Unsinkable Sam was first created for export to the US to show them what British beer is made of. You can expect rich maple and biscuity maltiness with a crisp, bitter finish and orangey/marmalade aroma from the UK-grown hops

29. Musket Brewery: Ball Puller 4%

An awesome, light copper coloured premier bitter. Releasing a caramel, floral, slightly malty aroma, whilst giving a taste of glorious summer fruits with a dry hop finish. A beer to saviour again and again!

30. Musket Brewery: Fife and Drum 3.8%

A Golden Ale which produces tantalising tastes and aromas of spice, honey, marmalade, floral and the merest hint of wild blackcurrant growing in the hedgerows of Kent.

31. Musket Brewery: Flintlock 4.2%

An unshamedly "Old School", traditional, best bitter, which will ignite your taste buds with its spicy orange undertones and just a hint of marmalade.

32. Musket Brewery: Trigger 3.6%

A very popular, easy drinking, hoppy, Pale Ale, that is full of flavour and character. A fantastic and eagerly sough-after session ale!

33. Old Dairy: Copper Top 4.1%

Our 4.1% rich dark premium bitter has a delicious toffee caramel body with chocolate undertones from the Maris Otter, Crystal and Chocolate malts. Balanced with a spicy and fruity bite from the Bramling Cross and Challenger hops, this is truly an ale to savour.

34. Old Dairy: Uber Brew 3.8%
